COMPETITION RULES

1. This event is 'with only one club competing' and is therefore not subject to upper or lower cut-off times.
2. The competition will be held under ASA Law and Regulations and ASA Technical Rules of Racing and is licensed by the ASA for entry into County Competitions, subject to County approval.
3. All entrants must be members of Swindon Dolphin ASC. ASA Registration numbers, at least Cat 1, must be included on the entry form.
4. If events are over-subscribed, the promoter reserves the right to return entries based on first come first served basis.
 - i) Each individual age group will be seeded on fastest entry times.
 - ii) Each individual age group will be allocated a proportion of the event based on the number of valid entries received.
 - iii) Shortfalls in one age group will be made by acceptances from other age groups at the promoter's discretion.
 - iv) The latest received entries in each individual age group will be rejected at the promoter's discretion.
5. Entry must be confirmed at the help desk at least 45 minutes before the published start of each session. Failure to do so may result in a swimmer not being accepted for that event.
6. Entries confirmed after the start list has been produced will only be accepted at the discretion of the Meet Manager and will be subject to availability of empty lanes in the slowest heats.
7. Start list for each event will be sent directly to the stewards in the marshalling area for distribution to the coaches.
8. Competitors must report to the marshal's two heats before their own and must remain in the marshalling area until called to compete. For the first event at the start of each session, competitors should report to the marshals at the end of the warm up.
9. Entries will be seeded into heats from submitted times and the slowest heats swum first. The fastest heat in each event will be spearheaded.
10. All events are heat declared winners and awards will be made to the top three places in each of the designated age groups.

COMPETITION CONDITIONS

1. Entries should be returned on the attached forms (with the appropriate fee being paid online), to the promoter or left in the pigeon hole at Milton Road.
2. The entry fee is £2 for 25m Events, £3.50 for 50m, 100m, 200m & 400m Events and £4.50 for 800m & 1500m Events.
3. The correct entry fee must have been paid or they will be treated as incorrect.
4. No other form of entry will be accepted and no entries will be accepted after the advertised closing date of 14th October 2017.
5. The promoter reserves the right to refuse or restrict entries as required to meet ASA conditions of meet Licensing.
6. Only competitors and officials will be permitted on poolside. All coaches and chaperones must have relevant accreditation and be registered on the child protection database.
7. During warm up, swimmers must be supervised by their coach.
8. A warm up Protocol will be issued and coaches are required to ensure that their swimmers adhere to the warm up procedure as outlined in the protocol or they may be requested to leave the pool.
9. All competitors are required to observe all safety announcements and conduct themselves in an appropriate manner at all times.
10. All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at the Link Centre & Marlborough College.
11. The Referee may need to alter or amend the conditions during the meet if unforeseen circumstances arise that are out of our control. Any situation not covered by the above conditions or the rules will be handled at the discretion of the Referee. The Referee's decision shall be final.
12. By submitting entries, consent is thereby given as required by the data protection act 1998 to the holding of personal information on computer.
13. Neither the promoter nor Swindon Dolphin ASC will be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during the meet.
14. The use of all photographic equipment is controlled at this Meet.
NO FLASH photography is permitted.
This guidance applies to all images and videos taken on any type of camera or recording device (including mobile phones) at the Meet.
Mobile phones that have a camera facility/hardware are recognised as a camera or photographic device. Swindon Dolphin Swimming Club follow The ASA guidance.
The full ASA Guidance on Photography can be found in Wavepower the ASA Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures available at www.swimming.org Video recording (including video streaming) of the Meet should only be done with parental consent and in line with the ASA guidelines.
15. The ASA encourage all spectators and participants at ASA events to make themselves familiar with the photography and filming arrangements for the event and be vigilant during that event.

Medley Skins Conditions

The top 6 swimmers from the girls 200IM, Event 11 and top 6 swimmers from the boys 200IM, Event 12, will qualify for this event.

If you are not present at the advertised warm up time, your place in the Medley Skins, will be offered to the next reserve swimmer.

The referee will pick, at random, 1 stroke for the girls and then 1 stroke for the boys.

The girls will swim first and the boys will swim 1min 30sec after.

The slowest swimmer (as determined by the referee) will be eliminated from the event and will choose the stroke for the next heat. The girls will pick the girls stroke and the boys will pick the boys stroke. This will be repeated at the end of each heat.

There will be 3 minutes between each heat from the start for the girls and 3 minutes between each heat from the start of the boys.

This process will continue until a winner for each event has been declared.

The first heat for both the girls and boys, will be started under a normal race start and rules, the next and following heats, will be given a 10 second warning (normally a bell or a whistle) and then just the start signal only.

The referee's decision will be final.

Times from this event, will not be submitted to rankings.
